**Directions**

**By Rail**

**From Southport station** turn left onto Chapel Street and walk to the end of this road. Turn right onto Eastbank Street, you should see the Scarisbrick Hotel straight in front of you. Turn left at the main Traffic lights, and the Prince of Wales hotel is 200 yards on the left hand side (opposite Argos).

Or turn left out of the station, cross over and walk through the Cambridge arcade to Lord Street. Then turn left and walk along Lord Street on the same side until you reach the Hotel.

**By Car - From Motorway**

**From the South** M6 to J26, take the M58 to Ormskirk, then follow A570 to Southport. Head for the centre turn left at the Junction with Lord Street, the Prince of Wales hotel is on the left.

**From the North**

M6 to J31, follow the A59 from Preston joining the A565 to Southport. Head for the centre turn left at the Junction with Lord Street; the Prince of Wales hotel is on the left.
